

LOGIN Seamlessly access & book materials available in Teaching Resources

- At school, select Login for automatic access
- At home, select **Login** and enter your employee number & password




SEARCH



- 1. In the library catalogue, choose **Teaching Resources** from the library drop-down menu.
- 2. Enter your search terms & select the magnifying glass to search.



FILTER



Use the limits in the left-hand navigation bar to narrow your search. Limit your search results by:

- FORMAT: To find videos, select the limiters DVD & Streaming Media
- **PUBLICATION DATE**: Select the most recent resources by narrowing the publication date range to the past 5-10 years
- **SOURCE**: Choose to view only results from a particular platform (i.e. Curio, Learn360, NFB)
- **TARGET AUDIENCE**: Narrow results to a particular age range.

Once you have selected your limiters, choose the **Refresh** button to view your updated results.



BOOK & SAVE

When you have found a video that you would like to view:

- **BOOK ITEM**: If the resource is in a physical format (i.e. DVD), select **Book Item** to borrow the resource. A booking calendar will open. From the calendar, select the date that you would like to borrow the item and click **Apply**.
- **ADD TO FAVOURITE**: Select **More** > **Add to favourite** to save streamed media & physical media resources to a list of favourites. Create multiple favourites lists for different topics.

Use CBC's Curio to find Canadian documentaries & news programs on a range of topics including science, health & politics in English & French.

Preview all content in its entirety prior to classroom use.

Select the **magnifying glass** to search for **specific topics**. Use **quotation marks** to find phrases (e.g. "global warming"). After searching, use **filters** to narrow by grade.



CLIP & PLAY



Share

Once you select a video, choose **Share** to access the video permalink which can be shared within TDSB.

Annotate

Login to your account to use the **Annotate** feature. Create chapters within a video and use the chapters to jump to specific sections of a video during a lesson.

□ Add to playlist

Use **Add to playlist** to group together videos on a particular theme.


BROWSE

- Use visual menu on homepage to select videos on specific subjects
- Choose Menu > Browse Videos in top right-hand corner to view list of all subjects & subtopics

SEARCH

- Enter keywords into search box & filter results by grade, subtopic & video type
- Select Search by Standards to search for videos related to specific curriculum strands

CLIP & PLAY



SHARE: Once you've selected a video, choose **Share** to access the video permalink which can be shared within TDSB.

PLAYLIST: Once logged in, select **Playlist** to save a selected video to lists of favourites or playlists.

SEGMENT: Once logged in, choose **Segment** to create a clip from a longer video. Play the video & select the **Set Start Time** & **Set End Time** buttons at the points you'd like to clip.

DOWNLOAD: Choose download to save the full video to your computer & play offline. *Only available for some content





- 2. Enter your school email & choose **Sign Up**.
- 3. Check your email for instructions on setting up your **password**.









- ADD TO YOUR PLAYLIST: Once logged in, choose the clock icon on a selected video to group together videos on a particular theme. Either select an existing playlist or create a new one.
 - CREATE CHAPTERS: Choose the scissor icon to clip out a section from a longer video. A clip editor will open. Click the green Create a Chapter button and drag the green markers to select your clip. Save your clip and add to a playlist, if desired. Access saved clips in MyCampus.
